

How to Make a Shaped Bird Feeder



What do you need?

- Cardboard
- Pen or pencil
- Cookie cutters
- Scissors
- Hole punch
- Dental floss, string or ribbon
- Knife
- Bird seed
- A shallow container



Steps

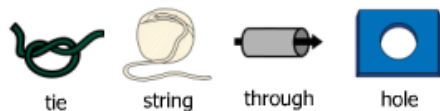
- 1) Grab everything you need before you start. Trace one of the cookie cutters onto the cardboard. If you want a heart bird feeder, choose a heart cookie cutter!



- 2) Cut out the shape and add a hole to the top where the string will go through. You want to keep this a little bit away from the edge to it doesn't rip.



- 3) Attached the string, dental floss or ribbon by putting it through the hole and tie it together.



- 4) Use your knife to spread out the peanut butter (or any nut or seed butter) on one side.



5) Fill the container with bird seed and press the peanut butter side into the bird seed.



6) Flip over the shape and spread the other side with the peanut butter.



7) Dip the newly covered side into the bird seed.



8) Hang up the bird feeder somewhere that the birds can get it!



9) All done!
